1. The Bantam final is open to all breeds of True & Rare True Bantam breeding pairs, i.e., Belgian, Dutch, Japanese, Pekin, Rosecomb, Sebright, Booted, Nankin, & Ohiki.
2. No more than two pairs from each qualifying show will be eligible to compete in the final.
3. Individual competitors may qualify no more than one pair for the final.
4. Chickens qualifying for entry in the final may not be entered in any other classes at the show.
5. The chickens must be penned in the cages provided at the showgrounds by 10.30 am.
6. Winners to be announced at 2 p.m.

7. These rules should be read in conjunction with the ISA Rules & Swinford Show Rules.

8. No bedding allowed in show cages.

9. Exhibitors must be owners & be present at the final.
