Class 1: Sport Horse or TB Broodmare

4 years old & over in foal or with a foal at foot. Open to thoroughbreds & non-thoroughbreds entered their respective stud books.

Class 2: Registered Irish Draught Broodmare

Approved as Class 1 or 2 in the Irish Draught Studbook, 4 years old or older, certified in foal or with foal at foot.

Class 3: Champion Broodmare

Open to first & second placed animals in classes 1 & 2. Entry to this class is free of charge. Prizes: 1st - Champion Rosette, 2nd - Reserve Champion Rosette

Class 4: Colt Foal

Progeny of a mare in Classes 1 & 2. All foals are to be led. Likely to be a high-class hunter or performance horse. RID foals will be judged as a separate class

Class 5: Filly Foal

Progeny of a mare in Classes 1 & 2. All foals are to be led. Likely to be a high-class hunter or performance Horse. RID foals will be judged as a separate class

Class 6: Champion Foal

Open to first & second-placed prize winners of classes 4 & 5.

Entry to this class is free of charge.

Class 94: Ridden Cob

Mare/gelding, four years of age or older & measuring more than 148cm. Open to Lightweight & Heavyweight or Maxi Cob.

Class 95: Light Weight Hunter

Mare/ Gelding. Four Years Old & Over. Capable of carrying up to 13 st, or 83kg.

Class 96: Middle-Weight/Heavy-Weight Hunter

Mare/gelding: capable of carrying over 13 st, or 83kg.

Class 97: Coloured Riding Horse -Mare/Gelding, four years old & over, over 148 cm.

Class 98: Champion Ridden Hunter

Four years old & over, exceeding 133 cm but not exceeding 143 cm. Riders U 14 years old on January 1st of the current year.

Class 103: 143 cm Show Hunter Pony - Mare or Gelding

Four years old & over, exceeding 133 cm but not exceeding 143 cm. Riders U 17 years old on January 1st of the current year.

Class 104: 153 cm Show Hunter Pony - Mare or Gelding

Four years old & over, exceeding 143 cm but not exceeding 153 cm. Riders must be U 20 on January 1st of the current year.

Class 105: Champion Show Pony

Open to first & second prize winners in classes 100 - 104.

Class 110: Connemara Pony Performance

Open to adults & children. Reg. Connemaras, 4 years old & over. Height of fences will not exceed 1m.

Class 111: Starter Stakes

Mare/Gelding. Four years old & over, not exceeding 123 cm. Riders U 11 years of age on January 1st of the current year. Height of fences is not to exceed 60cm

Class 112: 133 cm Working Hunter Pony

Mare/gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 133 cm. Riders must be U 14 years of age on January 1 of the current year. The height of fences is not to exceed 80 cm.

Class 113: 143 cm Working Hunter Pony

Mare/gelding, four years old & over, exceeding 133, not exceeding 143 cm. Riders U17 years old on January 1st of the current year. The height of fences is not to exceed 90 cm.

Class 114: 153 cm Working Hunter Pony

Mare/gelding, 4 years old & over 143cm, not exceeding 153 cm. Riders must be U20 yrs of age on Jan, 1st of the current year. The height of fences is not to exceed 1 m.

Class 115: Champion Working Hunter Pony

Open to first- & second-placed ponies in classes 89-93.

Entry to this class is free of charge.

Prizes: 1st - Champion Working Hunter Pony Sash and €75, 2nd - Reserve Champion Sash and €25

Class 116: Performance Green Hunter

Open to horses of any age in their first year of showing over fences. Riders over 16 years of age. The animal will not be ridden by the judge, and the competitor will perform an individual show. Fences not to exceed 70 cm.

Class 117: Performance Irish Draught - Mare or Gelding

Four years old & over, 155cm & over. Riders over 16 years of age. The animal will not be ridden by the judge, & the competitor will perform an individual show. Fences max height 1m

Class 118: Novice Working Hunter - Mare or Gelding

Four years old or older, 155cm & over. Riders over 16 years of age. Fences are not to exceed 90 cm.

Prizes: 1st - €100 and rosette, 2nd - €60 and rosette, 3rd - €40 and rosette

Class 119: Open Working Hunter

Open to horses four years old & over who are not Grade A or B showjumpers or advanced event horses. Fences not to exceed 1.10m.

Class 121: Working Hunter Championship
